

PDRA DISTRICTS – GEOGRAPHICAL DESCRIPTIONS

North District – The entire state of Virginia and everything east of a line beginning on the North Carolina-Virginia border at Highway 220, south to I-40 and then east to Highway 87 and south to Highway 421 all the way to Wrightsville Beach.

Central District – The area formed between the two borders of the North District and the South District.

South District – Everything south of a line beginning on the North Carolina-Tennessee border at Highway 321 south to Highway 73 and then south on Highway 220 to Highway 74 Bypass, then south on Highway 177 to the South Carolina border and the entire state of South Carolina.

The few members who live outside any of these three states will be allowed to designate on their membership application to which district they wish to be assigned.
